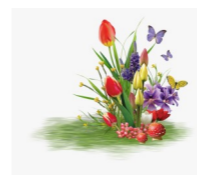
It's time to return the Trocaire Boxes, They can be dropped into the Churches at Mass time, the Parish Office or to Cong P.O.
